

PRIVACYSTatement AND GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

Introduction

Prospera B.V. (hereinafter referred to as "Prospera") considers careful and secure handling of privacy-sensitive information. This privacy statement outlines the personal data that is processed, how it is secured and for what purposes.

Use of personal data

Prospera may use your personal data for the following purposes:

- Providing services, including (legal and tax) advice, process supervision and
- drafting contracts
- collecting fees
- marketing and communication purposes

Personal data processing

Prospera processes the following personal data (types and categories):

- personal data for the purpose of service provision or provided by the person concerned from their own initiative and obtained in the context of the provision of services;
- contact data and other personal data necessary for the processing of files;
- contact data provided during introductory talks, events, seminars etc. such as data mentioned on business cards;
- personal data obtained from other sources, such as:
 - o personal data obtained from the Chamber of Commerce's Trade Register.
 - o Personal data available on public websites

Prospera processes personal data based on one of the following legal ground:

- Your consent;
 - o you may withdraw your consent at any time;
- Based on a contract or in the process of entering into a contract;

- A legal obligation;
- In connection with a legitimate interest (such as invitations to events of seminars).

Personal data security

Prospera prioritizes the security and safeguarding of your personal data. Taking into account the state of the art, Prospera ensures appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure a level of security tailored to the associated risks.

Retention period of personal data

Prospera does not retain processed personal data longer than necessary for its intended purpose or as required by law.

Privacy rights data of subjects

You have the right to request access to your data, request corrections or – in cases where we have no legal obligation to retain it – request deletion. You can also ask us to temporarily stop using your personal data or to transfer it to another organization. You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data. Complaints

You can lodge a complaint with the Personal Data Authority (“Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens”) if you are not satisfied with the handling of your request.
